### Suggested spelling activities

**Kim's Game** - Write 5 or more words correctly and allow 1 minute to study the list. Get someone to cover a word from the list and see if you can remember what the word is and how to spell it.

**Spelling tennis** - You say the first letter of the word and your partner says the next and so on. You can score if you wish. The server wins the point if the word is correctly spelled and the point goes to the opponent if a mistake is made.

**Speed spelling** - How many times can you write the word legibly and in joined handwriting in one minute? Can you beat your score the next day/week and the day/week after?

**Syllables** - break the word into syllables and write each syllable in a different colour.

**Make up a silly rhyme or story** to help you to remember the tricky part of the word.

**Dictation** - Get someone to say a sentence containing your spelling words and you write it. Check your spelling and punctuation.
