Dear Parents/Carers,

In the first full month of school we have been electing our pupils into their leadership roles. Please see information about our Pupil Council an Reading Ambassador roles in this newsletter.

Throughout this session our Senior Leadership Team (SLT) will be monitoring the attendance and late—comings of every child in our school. Every month we will be checking which pupils have dropped below 90% as per Scottish Borders Attendance policy. We will investigate the absences and if attendance continues to decrease we will make contact with parents to discuss how we can work together to support their child to be at school.

Our PTA have been in full-swing with organising various fundraising events. If you would like to get involved in the organising of any fundraising event please get in touch with our PTA members or I can point you in the right direction. Please get in touch with us if your work place does 'Match-Funding'.

This is a scheme where companies match the funds raised at event you have volunteered to help in your local community. This is a great way to boost our fundraising efforts.

We now have a special space in our school where you can collect pre-loved uniform in school. Please contact the school office if you need to replenish any items of school uniform. We are submitting an application to the Peebles District Round Table for a grant to purchase a 'Sharing Shed'. Meanwhile, I would like to re-iterate the importance of naming all clothing. We continue to have a large number of lost clothing and it is taking time to reunite owners with their belongings. We are also trying to encourage all the children to be responsible for their own items they bring to school and for them to create a personal checklist of what they need to remember.
